If you have not already done so, please sign up on Sunday morning, or call the church office to make your appointment. Photographs will be taken on October 16-17, and also on October 24-25. You may also make your appointment during the week by going online to our church website, and clicking on the "Portrait Sign Up" link.

New this year: in addition to getting a free 8x10 photo and a free church directory, you can get \$5 off your photo order by bringing a can of food to be donated to Davis Street Family Resource Center. And if you provide an email address when you sign up, you will find a \$10 gift coupon in the email reminder that will be sent to you 48 hours in advance of your appointment. And if you are a senior (60+), you get an additional 20% discount.

There is no obligation to purchase photographs – and price lists will be given out on Sunday mornings, so you can consider your options ahead of time.

We are doing our directory with a new company this year (Lifetouch), and there will be no "robo-calls" made ahead of time. Only our own church members will be phoning those who have not made an appointment - so please, sign up right away! We want EVERYONE of our church family (members and nonmembers alike) to be included in the directory! And the more people who are photographed, the more free activity pages we can include in the directory.



WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY

On Sunday, October 5th, Christians all around the world will be celebrating World Communion Sunday. As we commemorate our oneness in Christ around the table with believers everywhere, we will also receive the 2014 Peacemaking Offering.

Our congregation has a history of generously supporting this offering that helps to support our partners in the Presbyterian Church as they continue their efforts to be a part of God's peacemaking through-

out the world. Twenty-five percent of the offering will stay here in our local budget, for our own peacemaking work as the Session designates.


always half-full.
